

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Tuesday May 4, 2010 the Mayor and City Council formally announced the appointment of Robert Keith Corley as the City's new Chief of Police. Chief Corley comes to the City with law enforcement experience that spans 28-years in communications, jail operations, narcotics and criminal investigations, management training and budget responsibilities. His professional training includes Peace Officer Certification (P.O.S.T), graduation from the Federal Bureau of Investigations National Academy and the Law Enforcement Professional Management Program at Columbus State University.

Chief Corley's law enforcement career has been with the Monroe County Sheriff's Office since the mid 80's with leadership roles in such professional affiliations as; Rural Law Enforcement Technology Center, Georgia Civil Process Association of Georgia, Georgia Association of Law Enforcement Firearms Instructors, his POST hours of Certification exceed 3,000.

He is a graduate of the Forsyth-Monroe County Chamber of Commerce program, "Leadership Monroe", his public service in law enforcement commenced at the early age of 20, he and his wife have always called Forsyth their home and attend the First Baptist Church in Forsyth.
