Declaration of Local Emergency

Whereas, the City of Forsyth, Georgia has experienced an event of critical significance as a result of Hurricane Irma on September 10, 2017; and Whereas, in the judgement of the Mayor of the City of Forsyth, there exists emergency circumstances located in the City requiring extraordinary and immediate corrective actions for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Forsyth, including individuals with household pets and service animals; and Whereas, to prevent or minimize injury to people and damage to property resulting from this event;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by local and state law;

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED: that a local state of emergency exists and shall continue until the conditions requiring this declaration be abated.

WHEREFORE IT IS ORDERED:

- 1.) That the local emergency operations plan is hereby activated;
- 2.) That the following sections of the City of Forsyth Code be implemented if deemed appropriate: Section 25-5, Overcharging; Section 25-6, Registration of Building and Repair Services, Section 25-7, Closed or Restricted Areas and Curfews; and
- 3.) That the following measures also be implemented if deemed appropriate: Section 25-2(a)(4)c, d or such other measures as appropriate.
