ELECTIONS\*

**Sec. 9-1. Designation of specific office or post by candidate for alderman.**

Every candidate for the office of alderman shall designate the specific office or post for which he is a candidate. Such designation shall be entered on the ballot and ballot labels in such manner that, in the ensuing primary or election, such candidate shall only oppose such other candidate or candidates, if any, designating the same specific office or post.
