## RAILROADS

### **Sec. 18-1. Trains blocking crossings.**

It shall be unlawful for any railroad company or employee thereof to permit a railroad train to block any crossing in the city for longer than five (5) minutes.

### **Sec. 18-2. Speed limit for trains.**

No railroad locomotive, whether with or without cars attached, shall be run between the East Main Street crossing and Mile Post 218 within the limits of the city at a greater rate of speed than twenty (20) miles per hour. The engineer or conductor having in charge a locomotive or train shall be responsible for any violation of this section.
