

QUICK FACTS FOR NEW GARBAGE PICKUP SERVICE

- All residential recyclables will be picked up on Tuesday and must be in the bright green container.
- Recyclable items include cardboard, white paper, shredded paper, newspaper, junk mail, envelopes, magazines, file folders, aluminum, tin, glass, and plastic (#1-7).
- Highway 41 is the dividing line being used to divide the city into two separate days for garbage pickup – north (the Wal-mart side) of the Highway 41 line will have household garbage pickup on Wednesday and south (the Hospital side) of the Highway 41 line will have household garbage pickup on Thursday. All household garbage must be in the Advanced Disposal container.
- Bulk items for pickup include household furniture (sofa's, chairs, tables, etc.), carpet cut into 4x4 squares (no rolls of carpeting). All grass clippings, leaves, and pine straw must be bagged. All limbs must be less than 4 feet in length and 4 inches in diameter and not weigh over fifty (50) pounds. A maximum of two (2) cubic yards of yard waste and twenty (20) bags of clippings/leaves/pine straw will be collected on Friday.
- The garbage cart and recycle container is provided to you by Advanced Disposal and are to remain at the residence should you move from your present location. Fees will be assessed for lost carts or containers. Broken or damaged carts or containers can be returned to Advanced Disposal and a replacement cart or container will be provided at no charge.
