ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Contract #W4 – Forsyth, Georgia, Finished Water Main (Russellville WTP –to- City System)** will be received, by the **City of Forsyth** at the office of the **Mayor, 23 East Main Street, Forsyth, GA 31029**, until **11:00 A.M.** local time on **February 5, 2026**, at which time the Bids received will be “publicly” **opened** and read. The deadline to submit questions to the Engineer shall be at 5:00 P.M. on **January 29, 2026**.

The Project consists of constructing two (2) sections: (1000) The finished water main between the Russellville Water Treatment Plant -and- the existing water system network; and (2000) Site piping at the Cemetery Tank.

Section 1000

Connections will be made at several locations, including at West Main Street. The proposed water main consists of \pm 5,660/780/620/20 LF of 16"/12"/8"/6" PVC water main; \pm 625 LF of fusible 16" PVC water main installed via horizontal directional drill; \pm 180 LF of 24" jack & bore steel casing with 16" DIP carrier pipe; \pm 140 LF of 18" jack & bore steel casing with 12" DIP carrier pipe; \pm 7 fire hydrants and isolation gate valves; \pm 16 in-line gate valves; \pm 6 water main connection and/or tapping sleeve and valve connections; paving/sidewalk/other surface repairs; and miscellaneous items.

Section 2000

Tank site piping includes two (2) altitude valve vaults; piping / valves / fittings; and miscellaneous items.

The work shall include erosion control, traffic control, water main construction, and all incidentals required.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis, with additive alternate bid items as indicated in the Bid Form.

If the bid proposal includes alternative bid(s), the Owner reserves the right to give some consideration to any alternative bid. The amount of consideration shall be at the sole discretion of the Owner.
