## ELECTRIC RATE ADJUSTMENTS

Adjustments to the electric rates for the City of Forsyth were recently passed by the city council. This is the first electric rate increase for the City of Forsyth since 1/1/2015. This increase is necessary to continue to provide reliable electricity to the residents as the cost to generate electricity and maintain the city's electrical grid has risen greatly over the past 10 years.

**THE FOLLOWING RATE CHANGES WILL GO INTO EFFECT ON JANUARY 1<sup>ST</sup> 2025:**

### NEW BASE RATES FOR ALL RATE CATEGORIES

RESIDENTIAL	\$ 20.00
COMMERCIAL SMALL POWER NON-DEMAND	\$ 30.00
COMMERCIAL SMALL POWER W/DEMAND	\$ 30.00
COMMERCIAL MEDIUM W/ DEMAND	\$ 50.00
COMMERCIAL LARGE POWER W/ DEMAND	\$ 100.00
ALL OTHER COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL RATES	\$ 100.00

The following adjustment will be made to the Revenue Adjustment Rider (RAR-5). The RAR-5 will increase by \$0.01896 per kWh, from \$0.03759 per kWh to \$0.05655 per kWh. This rate is added to all applicable rate classes.
