

## **MINUTES**

### **FORSYTH CITY COUNCIL CALLED MEETING**

**AUGUST 22, 2018**

#### **ROLL CALL, INVOCATION, AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Mayor Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Hewett gave the invocation. Present for the meeting was Mayor Eric Wilson, Councilmembers Mike Dodd, Greg Goolsby, John Howard, and Chris Hewett. Also present was City Manager, Janice Hall. Councilmembers Julius Stroud and Melvin Lawrence were unable to attend the meeting; therefore, all unanimous votes will be four (4) votes (Dodd, Goolsby, Howard, and Hewett).

#### **APPROVAL OF UNIFORM AGREEMENT – TABLED AT AUGUST 20, 2018 COUNCIL MEETING**

Mrs. Hall reviewed the cost for the renewal agreement with Cintas for the public works and garage employees. Mrs. Hall stated the renewal pricing is considerably less than what we are currently paying Cintas. Mr. Hewett offered a motion to approve the renewal agreement with Cintas with the pricing presented. Seconded by Mr. Goolsby, the motion carried unanimously.

#### **REVIEW OF NEW CITY HALL BUILDING WITH ARCHITECTS**

Members of the Clark Nexsen architect team presented three final potential renderings for the exterior of the new city hall building. After a lengthy discussion regarding each rendering, likes and dislikes of each, Mr. Hewett offered a motion to approve the drawing which includes the tower with a rooftop on the tower. Seconded by Mr. Goolsby, the motion carried unanimously. Mrs. Hall reminded council that we need to provide a color scheme to American Tank for the water tank now that the exterior of the city hall building has been decided.

Chad Roberson, Clark Nexsen, stated that this concludes the schematic portion of the process and the next step is to begin the design element and preparing for documents. Mr. Roberson stated that this project should be ready for bid in January 2019 and construction should take 12-14 months.
